MEETING SUMMARY

PROJECT NAME: Olathe Fire Station #8
MEETING: Neighborhood Meeting

MEETING SUMMARY

A neighborhood meeting was held to inform the public about the proposed Fire Station #8 located at 148th and Lakeshore Drive. The attached map shows the mailing area that received invitations via mailed postcards. The format of the meeting was open-house style where representatives from the Olathe fire department, public works, parks and rec, as well as representatives from the design and construction team were available to answer questions and describe the project. In general, the feedback received from the neighborhood residents who attended the meeting were very favorable and in support of the proposed project. Some of the questions that were asked are listed below:

Q: What will the fire station do with the two houses that they currently occupy?

A: The city owns those properties and it hasn't been determined yet what the best use of them is, but plans to retain ownership.

Q: How much will this cost and who is paying for it?

A: The budget for the project is \$7M. It is funded through the city budget.

Q: When will it start and be completed?

A: Construction should start Summer 2020 if it stays on schedule and should be operational Summer 2021.

Q: How many people will staff the building?

A: Typical crew for an engine would be 3 people. That could vary from 3 to 6 people depending on how many apparatus is stationed here, but right now it is anticipated to have 3 permanent staff.

Q: Will the sirens be used at night?

A: Typically the fire department only uses the sirens in order to alert traffic. It is not anticipated that there will be much traffic at night along Lakeshore, however there is not a city ordinance that prohibits using sirens during certain hours. The fire department always strives to be good neighbors.

Q: Several questions were asked regarding non-project related infrastructure, including:


- Widening of Lakeshore Drive
- Lakestone Estates on sewer system (currently lagoons) and full water loop (currently a dead-end)
- Traffic Signals at 148th.

A: These potential future projects are not planned as part of the proposed fire station.

Q: Will there be a signal at the fire station?

A: There is not a signal planned.
