WHEREAS, the lives of all Olatheans are enriched by the contributions of the Deaf community as well as this opportunity to recognize their achievements within our great City.


NOW, THEREFORE, I, John Bacon, Mayor of the City of Olathe, do hereby proclaim September 2024 as
