## **ORDINANCE NO. 24-53**

AN ORDINANCE APPROVING THE DESCRIPTION AND SURVEY OF LANDS NECESSARY FOR THE PURPOSE OF RECONSTRUCTING AND MAINTAINING THE I-35 & SANTA FE INTERCHANGE/SANTA FE CORRIDOR (RIDGEVIEW TO MUR-LEN) IMPROVEMENTS [CITY PROJECT NO. 3-C-025-18] AND PROCEEDING TO ACQUIRE CERTAIN REAL PROPERTY AND REAL PROPERTY INTERESTS IN THE CITY OF OLATHE, KANSAS AS AUTHORIZED IN RESOLUTION NO. 24-1064, PASSED AND APPROVED BY THE GOVERNING BODY ON NOVEMBER 19, 2024.

## BE IT ORDAINED BY THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE CITY OF OLATHE, KANSAS:
