which can be a significant fire hazard if misused.

NOW, **THEREFORE**, I, John Bacon, Mayor of the City of Olathe, do hereby proclaim October 5-11, 2025 as

FIRE PREVENTION WEEK

and urge all Olatheans educate themselves on how to use these batteries safely;

and to install smoke alarms on each level and in every bedroom, to test them once a month, and to replace them at least every 10 years.
