

Proclamation


- WHEREAS,** the City of Olathe is committed to being an inclusive community, where all residents can live a productive life and enjoy a high quality of life; and


NOW, THEREFORE, I, John Bacon, Mayor of the City of Olathe, do hereby proclaim the month of October 2024 as
