## Joint City Council and Planning Commission Olathe Comprehensive Plan Kickoff Meeting

Eagle's Landing Tuesday, June 11, 2024 6:30 p.m. to 8:30 p.m.

I. Introductions: City Council attendance: Councilmembers Schoonover, Vakas, Vogt, Essex, Felter and Mayor Bacon. Also in attendance were City Manager Michael Wilkes, Deputy City Manager Susan Sherman, and various City staff.

- II. Comprehensive Plan Overview: Mr. Houseal explained the purpose of a Comprehensive Plan and why it is important for cities to have one.   - 3. Identify three specific projects or actions that you would like to see undertaken in Olathe.
  - 4. What are the primary strengths and assets of Olathe?
- V. Outreach Strategies: Mr. Houseal showcased the project website, the questionnaires, and other outreach mediums that will be used.
- VI. Next Steps: Mr. Houseal provided a list of the next steps for the project and thanked the council and commission members for their input.
