

# Care plan for dogs at 813 E Wabash St (Czernik)

## GENERAL CARE INFORMATION:

---

- Dogs are fed Taste of the Wild dog food for the adults and Taste of the Wild Puppy for the Puppies and are fed twice daily between 1.5-2.5 cups per meal depending on individual requirement
- Each dog gets walked on leash roughly  $\frac{3}{4}$  to 1 mile every morning after breakfast and again after dinner (Generally walks are between 6-7 both in the AM and PM). Waste bags are carried on all walks for proper disposal.
- Each dog takes 2 fish oil capsules daily for skin, coat and immunity benefits (and they consider it a great treat)
- Dogs and puppies have Seresto flea collars for flea and tick prevention
- Willow and Skyler are given 1 Hydroxyzine twice daily as needed for allergies
- Lulu, Skyler, Yogi and Winston are brushed weekly if not more frequently for shedding/coat health. All other short-coated dogs are brushed as needed.
- Dogs and puppies get paws massaged with organic coconut oil-based paw balm as needed for protection and paw care
- Each dog and puppy have access to a large self-refilling water bowl in the Kitchen and has access to a crate with bed for sleeping and or quiet time as he/she desires
- Since we have a 4-foot fence, dogs have an outdoor complex of a 10x10 and 5x15 kennel connected to each other and to the under-side of the back deck, which has been enclosed on 3 sides to serve as a large outdoor shelter with a sandbox for the pups to play in. Bedding is comprised cedar pet shavings.
- . Kennels are spot cleaned daily with all excrement removed and properly disposed of in biodegradable waste bags. Kennels are scrubbed, sanitized( and bedding changed)with pet safe outdoor cleaner/ water at least once weekly(more if necessary to ensure sanitary conditions and no odor for neighbors) connect to the under-side of the back deck, which has been enclosed on 3 sides to serve as a large outdoor shelter with a sandbox for the pups to dig in.
- While outside dogs have access to 3 large water dishes that are refilled several times daily as needed.
- All dogs are kept up to date on shots through Tractor Supply vaccination clinic, Spay and Neuter Kansas City, or our Vet, Quivera Crossing Animal Clinic (Dr.Fireyabend) .Medical/license records for each dog are kept in a 3 ring binder with a divider and folder for each dog.
- Dog first aid kits complete with animal antiseptic, hydrogen peroxide, animal styptic powder,spray to stop bleeding, bandages and gauze are kept on each floor in case of emergency.
