

Project Fact Sheet Little Cedar Creek (Park to Elm) Stormwater Improvements – Phase I 2-C-001-14 July 16, 2019

Description: This project will include enlarging the Loula Street culvert, channel improvements, retaining wall construction, demolition of 6 homes, and reduction of the risk of flooding of 2 other homes.

Justification: This project will address stormwater improvements for house and street flooding that occurs along Little Cedar Creek from West Park Street south to near West Elm Street.

Comments: This project has received Johnson County SMAC Program funds which will provide for 75% of design and construction up to a maximum of \$2,025,000.
