

PROCLAMATION


- WHEREAS,** since 1988 our nation has observed a month-long celebration to honor our nation's Hispanic heritage; and

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Michael Copeland, Mayor of the City of Olathe, do hereby proclaim September 15 – October 15, 2019, as


HISPANIC HERITAGE MONTH
