## **RESOLUTION NO. 19-1074**

## A RESOLUTION ADOPTING THE KANSAS DIVISION OF EMERGENCY MANAGEMENT REGION L MULTI-HAZARD MITIGATION PLAN APPROVED BY THE FEDERAL EMERGENCY MANAGEMENT AGENCY

- **WHEREAS**, the City of Olathe recognizes the threat that natural hazards pose to people and property within our community; and
- **WHEREAS**, undertaking hazard mitigation actions will reduce the potential for harm to people and property from future hazard occurrences; and
- **WHEREAS**, the U.S. Congress passed the Disaster Mitigation Act of 2000 ("Disaster Mitigation Act") emphasizing the need for pre-disaster mitigation of potential hazards; and
- **WHEREAS**, the Disaster Mitigation Act made available hazard mitigation grants to state and local governments; and
- **WHEREAS**, an adopted Hazard Mitigation Plan is required as a condition of future funding for mitigation projects under multiple Federal Emergency Management Agency ("FEMA") pre- and post-disaster mitigation grant programs; and
- **WHEREAS**, the City of Olathe fully participated in the FEMA prescribed mitigation planning process to prepare this Multi-Jurisdictional Hazard Mitigation Plan; and
- **WHEREAS**, the Kansas Division of Emergency Management and FEMA Region VII officials have reviewed the "Region L Multi-Jurisdictional Hazard Mitigation Plan," and approved it contingent upon this official adoption of the participating governing body; and
- **WHEREAS**, the City of Olathe desires to comply with the requirements of the Disaster Mitigation Act and to augment its emergency planning efforts by formally adopting the Region L Multi-Jurisdictional Hazard Mitigation Plan; and
- **WHEREAS**, adoption by the governing body for the City of Olathe demonstrates the jurisdiction's commitment to fulfilling the mitigation goals and objectives outlined in this Region L Multi-Jurisdictional Hazard Mitigation Plan; and
- **WHEREAS**, adoption of this Resolution legitimizes the plan and authorizes responsible agencies to carry out their responsibilities under the plan;

## NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE CITY OF OLATHE, KANSAS:

**SECTION ONE**: The City of Olathe adopts the "Region L Multi-Jurisdictional Hazard Mitigation Plan" as an official plan.

**SECTION TWO**: The City of Olathe will submit this Resolution to the Kansas Division of Emergency Management and FEMA Region VII officials to enable the plan's final approval.
