Description: The Old 56 Arterial Mill and Overlay Project from Lone Elm Road to 151st Street will provide a 2" mill and asphalt overlay, shoulder improvements, ADA ramp installation at the Robinson Drive intersection, traffic signal detection improvements, and pavement markings. Additionally, work will occur connecting Old 56 Highway to the City of Olathe Parks and Recreation maintenance facility with an asphalt entrance road including concrete curb and gutter installation, streetlights, and widening on Old 56 Highway to accommodate turn lanes.

Justification: This Street Preservation project will replace the asphalt surface pavement on Old 56 Highway which has fallen below our target condition index, and will include a new entrance road for the City of Olathe Parks and Recreation maintenance facility.
