Description: The Provence Village Neighborhood Streets Improvement Project will include full depth asphalt pavement and subgrade replacement, replacement of concrete curb and gutters, installation of sidewalk, replacement of driveway approaches, streetlight installation, and stormwater improvements.

Justification: The Provence Village Neighborhood Streets Improvements Project provides for full reconstruction of Payne Street, Brockway Street, and Provence Street, south of Old 56 Highway, which is deteriorated to a condition beyond preventative maintenance provided by a Street Preservation Program project.
