

PROCLAMATION


- WHEREAS,** John Allison has dedicated 34 years of his life to the education of children, to helping our young people learn and grow and to go out and have an impact in the world; and

NOW, THEREFORE, I, John Bacon, Mayor of the City of Olathe, do hereby proclaim May 4, 2021, as


