SUMMARY:

In its 15th year, the Downtown Outdoor Sculpture Exhibit (DOSE) provides the community a unique outdoor sculpture display which exhibits a collection of works, introducing a variety of artistic approaches. Nine sculptures were reviewed by the Council at the February 19th meeting.
