### ITEM DESCRIPTION:

### SUMMARY:

10 sculptures and 3 alternates were recommended by the Olathe Public Art Committee for the 2021 Downtown Outdoor Sculpture Exhibit. The sculptures were reviewed by Council at the February 2<sup>nd</sup> meeting. After considering feedback from the Council, the committee has recommended 9 sculptures to be featured in the 2021 Exhibit.

The 9 sculptures recommended to be featured in the exhibit are:

The sculptures will be leased by the City for one year. Final sculpture locations are still to be determined; it is necessary for site location to be flexible, as sculptures may need to be relocated after arrival to ensure the best fit for each sculpture site.

**FINANCIAL IMPACT:**

The annual budget for the Downtown Outdoor Sculpture Exhibit is \$15,000. In 2021, the estimated total expense is \$20,000. Leftover funds from the 2020 Exhibit will be utilized to cover the additional costs.
